This petition is filed at the instance of five petitioners who have challenged the individual notices (Annexures P/1 to P/5) issued to them.

The said petitioners have filed their separate replies to the individual notices issued to them but so far no adverse order has been passed. Counsel for the petitioners submits that respondent No.3 has to pass the order after receiving the reply to the show cause notice, but he has not done the same. He has further submitted that the petitioners would be satisfied if respondent No.3 is directed to pass the speaking order after affording an opportunity to the petitioners.

I do not find any reason to deprive the petitioners of the prayer made by them as it only pertains to the passing of the order by respondent No.3 after affording an opportunity of hearing to them. Therefore, the present petition, without notice, is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the matter pending before

it in the shape of show cause notices as early as possible preferably

within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order. It is needless to mention that in case any adverse order is to be passed, the petitioners would have a right to challenge the same in accordance with law.
