The petitioner is stated to be a self-financed School of Nursing at Sirsa. While in some of the sessions it remained closed, it has decided to revive itself and consequently applied to the Director General, Medical Education & research-respondent No.2 to grant it permission for admission to ANM (Auxiliary Nursing Midwifery) Course for the academic session 2017-18. The request has been made on 30.09.2017. It is claimed that the petitioner-School does not require any permission from Indian Nursing Council, for which reliance is placed on a decision of the High Court of Karnataka.

Be that as it may, the principal relief sought in this writ petition is to direct respondent No.2 to take a decision on the request made by the petitioner-School on 30.09.2017.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any views on the question whether or not the petitioner-School is obligated to obtain permission from Indian Nursing Council, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director General,

Medical Education & Research, Haryana, Panchkula to pass an appropriate speaking order on the petitioner's application dated 30.09.2017 within one week from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order. It shall be appreciated if representative of the petitioner-School is heard before passing the order.
