It appears that this *petition* was disposed of on March 26, 2015.

It was directed that respondents No.2 to 7 would look into the matter.

Petitioner remains unrepresented today. Similar was the situation on the last date of hearing.

On behalf of the Corporation, it has been submitted that a civil suit is already pending between the parties at Sangrur. Though the colony is a private colony, but street lights and roads have been provided by the Municipal council. This contention is controverted by respondents No.8 to 10.

As the disputed question of facts are envisaged, this court does not intend to interfere in writ jurisdiction. Besides, a civil litigation is

already pending. This petition is without any merit and is hereby dismissed.
The concerned authority shall also be at liberty to take a decision in terms of
order dated March 26, 2015 passed by this court.
