Petitioner filed the present petition claiming that his son was married to respondent No. 6, about 14-15 years back, who used to ill-treat her husband. Petitioner has levelled allegations that respondent No. 6 used to give some poisonous supplement in the food of the deceased as a result of which he was murdered in connivance with her family members.

In this context, the investigating agency appears to have, after registration of FIR, looked into the matter and found nothing suspicious. Dissatisfied with the investigation, the present writ petition has been filed by the father of deceased, husband of respondent No. 6, having reasonable apprehensions that his son has died an unnatural death.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that the Director General of Police, Punjab will constitute a Special Investigation Team consisting of two gazetted officers not below the rank of Superintendent of Police and investigation will be conducted

under the supervision of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala. The report will be submitted by the Special Investigation Team within a period of three months. The team will be constituted within a period of 15 days after receipt of certified copy of the order. The said investigation team will look into the matter within a period of three months of its constitution and submit a report to the Director General of Police, Punjab. If need be, further action will be taken accordingly.
