The petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to ensure that helmets/protective headgears are made mandatory for women (drivers as well as pillion riders) of a two wheeler excluding Sikh women wearing turban to ensure safety. Further prayer has also been made to direct the respondents to amend the Rule 193 of the Chandigarh Motor Vehicle Rules, 1990.

2. After arguing for sometime, the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition, with liberty

to the petitioner to approach the authorities concerned to raise all the pleas as raised in the present writ petition.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
