The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus*, directing the official respondent No.2 to conduct fresh elections with respect to the General Secretary and comply with the Guidelines of the Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports dated 01.05.2010 (Annexure P-3) as well as the Rules/Memorandum (Annexure P-2) of the Badminton Association of India with regard to the tenure of the General Secretary with immediate effect as the same has not been done despite the lapse of more than 4 years since the adoption of the said rules by respondent No.3 vide letter dated 09.04.2011 (Annexure P-4) and despite

the fact that Respondent No.1 is the Hony. Secretary of the Punjab Badminton Association from the last 30 days.

2. Mr. Salil Sabhlok, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner with no objection from Sh. Kawaljyot Singh, Advocate, who was earlier representing the petitioner and he has filed his vakalatnama duly signed by the petitioner, which is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he has instructions to withdraw the present writ petition.
