The prayer made in this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent to consider the petitioner to be eligible in view of Annexure P-3 dated 02.12.2016 whereby 119 candidates were considered eligible after removing their respective discrepancies and to allow him to appear provisionally in the main written examination of Haryana Superior Judicial Service Examination going to be held on 10.02.2017 to 12.02.2017.

2. The petitioner applied for the post of the Additional District and Sessions Judge in the State of Haryana on 15.09.2016 i.e. after the last date for submission of form in terms of Annexure P-1 dated 17.08.2016. The main written examination is scheduled for 10.02.2017 to 12.02.2017. It was also not disputed by

learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had applied after due date of submission of the application form. No satisfactory explanation had been furnished by the learned counsel for not submitting the form in time.

3. In such circumstances, we do not find any ground to interfere in the present writ petition and the same is hereby dismissed.
