Petitioners claimed that they had been allotted the work of laying water pipes under the jurisdiction of Municipal Corporation, Gurgaon, by way of bidding process but despite the completion of the work, payments have not been made for the said works.

Through instant petition, a direction is sought for requiring the respondents to make the payments. In this context, the petitioners have already submitted requests to the Executive Engineer and the concerned Minister vide Annexure P-5 and P-6, dated July 4, 2016 and July 16, 2016, respectively.

After considering the facts and circumstances of the case, I am of the opinion that the ends of justice would be adequately met in case a direction is issued to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners within a period of two months after the receipt of a certified copy of the order at this stage.

Notice to Advocate General, Haryana.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Addl.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice.

Counsel for the petitioners is directed to hand over a copy of the petition in the office of Advocate General, Haryana, during the course of the day.

This petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to the Executive Engineer, Division VI, Municipal Corporation, Gurgaon to consider the claim of the petitioners as put-forth in representation dated July 4, 2016, within a period of two months after the receipt of the certified copy of the order.
