The matter has been settled between the parties.

The learned counsel for the appellants has accepted the offer made by learned Insurance Company for payment of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees two lacs only), over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal as full and final settlement of the claim. Out of total enhancement, Rs.1,50,000/- shall be payable to appellant No.1-Kashmir Kaur (widow) and Rs.50,000/- shall be payable to appellant No.3-Jaswant Kaur (mother of the deceased) as requested by the learned counsel for the appellants.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque/demand draft for Rs.2, 00,000/- (Rupees two lacs only) with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 21.01.2018. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque / demand draft from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
