This petition has been filed for quashing the order dated 13.03.2012 (Annexure P-3).

On the last date the following order was passed:-

*“On 16.05.2017 the following order was passed :-*

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the company is under winding up in view of an order passed by the Delhi High Court in CO-PET-478 of 2012 titled as Shanti Parkash Gupta and others Vs. Ebony Retail Holdings Ltd, decided on 26.5. 2016 by which Provisional Liquidator has been appointed and compliance report has been sought. It is submitted that the petitioner would seek permission from the Delhi High Court for the purpose of pursuing this petition before this Court in view of the provisions of Section 279 of the Act of 2013 and Section 446 of the Old Act.*

*On his request, adjourned to 11.7.2017.”*

*Today learned counsel for the petitioner prays for more time to ascertain what has been done by the petitioner to the submission made on 16.05.2017.*

*Last opportunity is granted.*

*Adjourned to 24.10.2017.”*

Counsel for the petitioner has candidly accepted that even till today necessary permission has not been taken from the Delhi High Court.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
