AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

At first glance the facts of this case seem to be covered by the decision of this Court dated 11.10.2017 passed in CWP No.23305 of 2017, titled as *Jasbir and others vs. The State of Haryana and others*. However, counsel for the petitioners has stated that at that time the subsequent order of the Supreme Court dated 13.10.2017 had not yet been passed and now after the order of the Supreme Court the original directions have been modified. I find that it is indeed so. Counsel for the petitioners further points out that while disposing of many such cases earlier this Court directed the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners in those cases but no time limit was granted and therefore in many cases there is inordinate delay to decide the representation.

In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners with regard to the regular permit/temporary permit in accordance with the

prevailing position of law after considering the effect of the orders of the Supreme Court dated 04.09.2017 and 13.10.2017. The necessary orders be now passed within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
