JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By virtue of the instant civil writ petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought direction to the respondents to release the benefits of family pension including arrears of family pension, and other benefits relevant under other heads, under the revised pay scales along with arrears of pay on account of revision of pay scale from November, 2011 and other admissible benefits in the revised pay scale, in respect of Tarsem Singh husband of the petitioner who had died during his service on November 17, 2008 in favour of the petitioner who is wife of the aforesaid deceased employee. AS WELL AS for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent to pay the interest @ 18% per annum, on the aforesaid amounts, for causing delay in the disbursal of the same.

Though vide interim order dated 15th May, 2017 passed by the Coordinate Bench, a direction was issued to the respondent to pass a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy thereof and to place the same on file but at the same time, the

direction was also issued to make the payment of the monthly financial assistance. However, while considering the case of the petitioner, the relief claimed by the petitioner through the instant petition, has been declined vide order dated 12th September, 2017, the copy of which has been furnished today in the Court by learned State counsel.

In view of passing of order dated 12th September, 2017, instant petition has rendered infructuous and the only option left with the petitioner is to challenge order dated 12th September, 2017 if she feels so aggrieved.
