By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to permit her to exercise new option in view of changed circumstances created by change in Master Scale in terms of CWP No. 7464 of 2009, Surinder Kumar and others vs. State of Punjab and others, decided on 25.02.2010 and also grant her all consequential benefits accruing after exercise of fresh option i.e. re-fixation of pay, payment of arrears of salary and pensionary benefits to her in terms of letter dated 07.02.2011 and 15.03.2017.

2. At the very outset, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that though a legal notice dated August 11, 2016 (P-11) was served upon the respondents but till date neither any reply nor any conscious decision

has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and decide the afore-said legal notice (P-11) within a time bound manner.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her legal notice (P-11) and to decide the same in accordance with law, service rules as well as instructions issued by the Government from time to time within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authorities, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
