By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the daily wages service rendered by him w.e.f. July 09, 1983 to October 21, 1992 towards qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary benefits and also to grant him all the pensionary benefits i.e. revised pensionary benefits such as pension, gratuity, leave encashment and other retiral benefits along-with interest @ 12% per annum.

2. At the very outset, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that representations dated November 14, 2014 (P-4) and June 12, 2017 (P-5) were moved by the petitioner to the respondents but till date no action has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and decide the representation (P-5) within a time bound manner.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation (P-5) and to decide the same in accordance with law, service rules as well as instructions issued by the Government from time to time within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authorities, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
