By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count his entire service w.e.f April 30, 1989 to July 30, 1996 towards pensionary benefits, in view of order dated November 18, 1991 passed by Presiding Officer, School Tribunal Punjab (P-1) and to release the due benefits to the petitioner alongwith interest @12% per annum

2. At the very outset, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that though a legal notice dated August 25, 2017 (P-3) was served upon the respondents but till date neither any reply nor any conscious decision has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and decide the afore-said legal notice (P-3) within a time bound manner.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice (P-3) and to decide the same in accordance with law, service rules as well as instructions issued by the Government from time to time within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authorities, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
