The petitioner is a Deputy Commandant in BSF. He has made to this Court the following prayers:-

“i) issue writ, order or directions especially in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to get the matter investigated on the leveled allegations against respondent No.12 & 13 through an independent agency like CBI/NIA in National interest.

ii) issued direction to respondent No.3 & 4 to defer/stay the Staff court of Inquiry (SCOI) ordered dated 17.09.2015 amended twice vide order dated 10/13/2015 & 28.10.2015 & other issues raised by the respondent no.13 affecting petitioner's carrier/family/reputation till final outcome of investigation against private respondent No.12 & 13.

iii) further issued direction to respondent no.1 to extend facilitation to the petitioner as requested in his letter dated 03.11.2015 (Annexure-P-27) for

fair and impertial investigation send for the record of the case;

iv) issue any other writ, order or direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit in the facts and circumstances of the case;

If the petitioner is a busy body he can take his prayers elsewhere. The writ jurisdiction cannot be ignited on this petition that too and when the Deputy Commandant stands against his parent para military force.

The petition stands dismissed.
