1. In the instant writ petition, petitioner has sought for staying the departmental proceedings initiated against the petitioner vide order dated 04.04.2015 (Annexure P/1).
2. The petitioner while he was in service, parallel proceedings were initiated. When both the proceedings were initiated, the petitioner questioned the validity of departmental proceedings on the ground that on identical issue criminal proceedings are being held. In view of the pendency of the criminal proceedings, this Court granted interim order on 21.03.2016 staying the operation of the departmental proceedings. During the pendency of this petition, on 09.03.2016 the petitioner has been convicted and sentenced was ordered on 11.03.2016.
3. In view of these developments, present petition do not survive for consideration. Accordingly, instant writ petition stands dismissed. The official respondents are at liberty to take appropriate action in accordance with law.
