Rajesh Bindal, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail of appropriate remedy before Debt Recovery Appellate Tribunal (DRAT) against the impugned order dated 29.8.2017 passed by Debts Recovery Tribunal-II (DRT), Chandigarh. He further submitted that as the matter remained pending in this Court and as the petitioners had been approaching the bank to settle the issue, they may be granted some time to file appeal before DRAT.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. As there would be delay in filing the appeal before DRAT, in case, appeal is filed before DRAT within a period of one week along with application seeking condonation of delay, the application for condonation of delay shall be considered sympathetically.
