Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon judgments of this Court in *Jasbir Singh vs. State of Punjab and others, Anil Kumar Dahiya vs. Union of India and others*, as also *Jai Parkash vs. The State of Haryana and others*, to submit that the petitioner is entitled to counting of his past service in the respondent department.

In respect of his grievance, he is stated to have got issued a legal notice to the respondents, a copy of which is Annexure P-8.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice of the petitioner (Annexure P-8), dated 02.05.2017, by passing a speaking order within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, taking into account the aforesaid judgments of this Court.

It is also clarified that in case a speaking order has already been passed, giving such detailed reasons, then only a short order need be passed, annexing therewith the detailed order already passed (if any).
