Petitioner is a Sarpanch of Village Jagirpur District Ludhiana.
He had submitted a representation to Deputy Director, Civil Supplies,
Ludhiana, against three depots of Village Jagirpur, complaining about the
irregularities.

Counsel informs that the licenses of the said depots stand
cancelled.

Through instant petition, the petitioner had sought action on his
representation annexure P-5.

So far as prayer of the petitioner for cancellation of the depots is concerned, the petition has become infructuous.

Counsel for the petitioner at this stage has submitted that a further direction be issued that for selection of persons to allot depots, fair procedure be adopted and the persons who had earlier been found to have committed irregularities, be not considered.

The request of the petitioner appears to be beyond the scope of the writ jurisdiction. It is observed that in case the petitioner is aggrieved by any wrong selections, it will be open for him to approach the competent authority but no ground is made out for interference at this stage.

Petition is dismissed.
