By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release all the pensionary benefits/consequential arrears with interest by counting the previous regular service under the Central Govt. Undertaking (Jawahar Novodaya Vidayala) from June 30, 1989 to August 05, 1998 without any break for the purpose of grant of pension by respondent No.3.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though a legal notice dated March 18, 2017 (P-7) was moved to the respondents but till date, no action has been taken. He further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is given to respondents, to decide the aforesaid legal notice, within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the

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legal notice dated March 18, 2017 (P-7) and take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case, petitioner still feels aggrieved of the order passed by concerned authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
