By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to count the probationary services of the petitioners served with respondent No.4 till their retirement for the purpose of pensionary benefits and to revise their pension and to release the arrears along with retiral/consequential benefits with interest @ 12%.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though representation dated July 11, 2017 (Annexure P-1) was moved to the respondent No.2 but till date, no action has been taken. He further submits that petitioners feel satisfied in case direction is given to respondents, to decide the representation, within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in the

representation dated July 11, 2017 (Annexure P-1) and take a conscious decision within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case, petitioners still feel aggrieved of the order passed by concerned authority, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
