As per case of the petitioner, total 1227 posts of Revenue Patwari and 857 posts of Canal Patwari were advertised. Petitioner belongs to General category. Out of aforesaid total posts, 496 posts and 421 posts, respectively were for General category. Petitioner participated in the selection process and was at Sr. No.1140 in the merit list. As per information of the petitioner, he has been kept in the waiting list. The posts are still lying vacant but the petitioner has not been considered being in the waiting list. The petitioner made a representation dated 27.04.2017 (Annexure P-4) to the respondents, but no action has been taken.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case directions are issued by this Court to consider his representation dated 27.04.2017 (Annexure P-4).

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to consider his representation dated 27.04.2017 (Annexure P-4). In case his name is found to be in the waiting list and the posts are still lying vacant, the petitioner be considered as per his merit. The necessary exercise be done within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of order. In case the averments made in the representation are not accepted by the respondent, then a detailed speaking order be passed as per averments made in the representation.
