The prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to entertain the appeal without insisting on prior payment of 25% against order of the Excise and Taxation Officer-cum-Designated Officer dated 23.07.2008 whereby demand of ₹ 93,78,561/- has been created.
