Petitioner is a candidate for recruitment to the post of Female Supervisor in the department of Women and Child Development, Department, Haryana pursuant to the advertisement No.1 of 2011 (Category No.3). Petitioner's candidature has not been considered for selection and appointment to the post of Female Supervisor on the score that she has scored lesser percentage than the last selected candidate under the BC-A category.

Grievance of the petitioner is that while awarding marks for experience certificate, the same were not appropriately awarded as per guidelines for awarding marks with reference to the number of years of experience. Thus, petitioner's contentions is that he is entitled for 4.05 marks. If 4.05 marks are awarded, his marks would be 47.19. Whereas last candidate who has been selected has scored 44.96 marks.

In view of the above facts and circumstances, concerned selecting authority is directed to re-examine the petitioner's claim for awarding of marks to the experience certificate to the extent of 4.05 marks and re-consider the petitioner's candidature for selection and appointment to

the Female Supervisor under the BC-A category and issue order of appointment within a period of three months from today. Such order of appointment, if any, would be on notional basis.

Accordingly, petition stands allowed.
