Learned counsel for respondents No. 2 to 4 fairly submitted that pursuant to order dated 05.09.2017, respondents have extended benefit of gratuity to the petitioner on 09.10.2017. In so far as provident fund is concerned, papers have been forwarded to the Regional Provident Fund Authority.

In view of these facts and circumstances, present petition do not survive for consideration. Regional Provident Fund Authority is directed to consider the grievance of the petitioner in respect of provident fund and extend the benefit if the petitioner is otherwise eligible in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. If he is not eligible in that event speaking order be passed and communicate the order to the petitioner at the earliest.

With these observations, Civil Writ Petition stands disposed of.
