Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to family pension to her after considering the husband of petitioner regular on completion of 5 years of service as work charge employee and to make the payment of arrears w.e.f. March 07, 1992 with 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a legal notice dated November 04, 2016 (P-8) was served upon the respondents but till neither any reply nor any conscious decision has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and decide the afore-said legal notice (P-8) within a time bound manner.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her legal notice (P-8) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order considering all the facts narrated in the aforesaid legal notice within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
