Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release all the retiral benefits accrued to her i.e. gratuity, leave encashment, Provident fund, arrears of dearness allowance and arrears of three months salary etc. along with interest @ 12% per annum from the date it became due till its actual realization..

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner stood retired on August 31, 2017 on attaining the age of superannuation but till date nothing has been paid to her. Even, legal notice dated October 03, 2017 (P-1) served upon the respondents, did not fetch any reply. He further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and decide the afore-said legal notice (P-1) within a time bound manner.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice (P-1) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order considering all the facts narrated in the aforesaid legal notice within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
