The instant petition has been preferred by the DAV College Trust and Management Society as also DAV College Managing Committee, praying for issuance of writ of mandamus for directing the appropriate authority under the State of Punjab to release the outstanding amount towards grant-in-aid.

On the last date of hearing, i.e. 11.07.2017, counsel representing the Society, had apprised the Court that certain amount towards grant-in-aid has already been released but the outstanding grant-in-aid to be paid by the State Government, is Rs.60 lacs approximately. Accordingly, State counsel was directed to complete instructions as to in what time frame the balance amount would be released to the petitioner-Society as per entitlement.

During the course of resumed hearing today, Mr. Avinit

Avasthi, AAG, Punjab, upon Instructions from Mr. Rajneesh Goyal, L.O., Office of DPI College Punjab, makes a statement that the entire outstanding grant-in-aid, to the petitioner-Society as per entitlement, would be released positively within a period of eight weeks from today.

Mr. R.S. Cheema, learned counsel representing the petitioners, submits that in the light of such categorical statement and undertaking having been furnished, he does not press the petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.
