Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to step up his pay at par w.e.f. July 01, 2006 equal to Sh. Mangal Singh, UDC and Davender Singh Hooda UDC, Juniors to the petitioner in view of the circular dated March 02, 2016 (P-1) and to release all the consequential benefits accrued in favour of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on the basis of representation dated July 27, 2016 (P-2) moved by the petitioner to respondent No.2, the case of the petitioner for the grant of benefit(s) claimed through instant petition was initiated and though a correspondence is going *inter-se* with the officers of the department but till date no final decision has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation (P-2) within a time bound

manner.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in representation (P-2) and to take a conscious decision strictly in view of judgments passed by this Court vide CWP No.25750 of 2013 (Annexures P-8) titled as Rajbir Singh Vs. Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited & others and CWP No.11254 of 2010 (Annexure P-9) titled as Neelam Rani Vs. State of Haryana and others, by passing a speaking order considering all the facts narrated in the aforesaid representation within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. In case any adverse order passed by the afore-said authority, petitioner shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
