DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is aggrieved by action of the respondents in not allowing her to join duty as she was on leave from 13.09.2017 to 18.09.2017. Thereafter, due to ailment, the petitioner requested for extension of leave upto 28.09.2017 and when she went to join on 29.09.2017, she was not allowed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that not only the oral request was made by the petitioner but she made a representation to the respondents on 10.10.2017 and prior to that, a legal notice was also sent on 06.10.2017. The notice was served upon the petitioner and the same was responded by her immediately but still, she has not been allowed to join her duties. Reply to the notice was given but neither any action has been taken nor it has been intimated to the petitioner as to how the reply of the notice was not satisfactory. Learned counsel also submits that the petitioner would

be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued by this Court to decide the pending representation dated 10.10.2017 (Annexure P-5) within some stipulated period.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case and also by considering that the representation of the petitioner pending before the respondent authorities has not been decided so far, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to take action on the representation dated 10.10.2017 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
