Petitioner herein is the widow of late Sh. Davinder Singh, who was initially enrolled as a Special Police Officer in Police District Batala on 22.02.1994. Subsequently, husband of the petitioner was selected as Constable on 25.03.2007 and granted the Constabulary number on 26.03.2007.

Claim raised in the instant petition is for issuance of directions to the respondent/authorities to treat deceased husband of the petitioner to be governed under the Old Pension Scheme applicable to the appointees prior to 01.01.2004 and by counting his previous period of engagement as S.P.O.

During the course of hearing today, State counsel upon instructions SI-Rattan Masih 9th Battalion PAP, Amritsar, has very fairly stated that the claim of the petitioner would be squarely covered in terms of the judgment dated 11.05.2016 passed by this Court in CWP No.11802 of 2008 titled as "Paramjit Kaur Vs. The State of Pujab and others" (Annexure P-7).

Accordingly, instant writ petition is allowed in terms of the judgment rendered by this Court in Paramjit Kaur's case (supra).
