By these two petitions the petitioners have claimed that they could not be prevented from taking the final year examination. On the last date Indian Nursing Council was impleaded as party which is the body which is to regulate the standards. Today, Mr. Munish Jolly, Advocate has shown to the counsel for the petitioners the latest regulations of 2014 wherein it has been explicitly stated that though the total period for clearing the GNM Course is 3 years, yet before being permitted to attempt the final year examination students have to show that they have cleared all the papers of 1st and 2nd year. In this view of the matter, learned counsel for the petitioners has very fairly stated that petitioners have only one back-log paper which they have attempted and pray that in case they are able to clear that paper they be allowed to take the final year examination.

I find it to be a fair request and even while dismissing the petitions as laid, I direct that in case the petitioners are able to clear their back-log exam during the papers which are being conducted these days they be allowed to take the final year examination as and when it is held on the next occasion. Learned counsel for the respondents have also not pointed out any infirmity in the request.

Both the petitions stand dismissed with the above clarification.

Since the main cases have been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
