By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the official respondents No.1 to 4 to revise his pension in terms of notification dated 06.02.2015 (Annexure P-2) as well as the 7th Pay Commission issued vide notification dated 03.03.2017 (Anenxure P-10).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though legal notice dated 15.06.2015 (Annexure P-9) was moved to respondent No.2 but till date, no action has been taken. He further submits that the petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is given to respondents, to decide the legal notice, within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in legal notice dated 15.06.2015 (Annexure P-9) and take a conscious decision within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case, petitioner still feels aggrieved of the order passed by concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
