Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case is covered by the judgment in Ranjit Singh Vs. Union of India, CWP-1908-2010 decided on 01.09.2011 permitting the issuance of the passport to under trial.

Learned counsel for respondents No. 1 and 2 submits that as per directions in the above said case, passport can be issued to the petitioner which will be surrendered by the petitioner before the trial Court.

It is agreed between the parties that the passport will be issued to the petitioner and will be dispatched to the Court of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Hoshiarpur where the criminal case is pending against the petitioner. The said passport shall be released to the petitioner subject to the satisfaction of the trial Magistrate.
