Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to count the past service of the petitioner rendered on daily wage basis from 10.09.1990 to 31.01.1996 as qualifying service towards pension and other retiral benefits and release the same with effect from the deemed date of retirement of the petitioner i.e. on 30.09.2014 along with arrears thereof with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though a legal notice dated 09.10.2017 (P-6) was moved to the respondents, but till date, no action has been taken so far by the concerned department. He further

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submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is given to respondent No. 4, to decide the aforesaid legal notice, within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.4, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her representation dated 09.10.2017 (P-6) and take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case, petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the order passed by concerned authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
