The instant writ petition was filed in the year 2014 seeking writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of the letter/office order dated 09.07.2013, whereby, selection process has been initiated by the respondents for the post of Supervisor amongst the Anganwari Workers.

The writ petition was listed on 07.04.2014, but when no one had put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners even at the second call, in the interest of justice, the matter was adjourned to 09.05.2014. Thereafter, on 09.05.2014, on the request of learned counsel for the petitioners, the matter was adjourned to 25.07.2014. On 25.07.2014, again there was no appearance on behalf of the petitioners even at the second call and in the interest of justice, the matter was adjourned to 30.09.2014. The petition was

listed on the said date, wherein, learned counsel for the petitioners was directed to place on record the copy of advertisement by which the petitioners were called from amongst Anganwari Workers for selection as Supervisor and the matter was adjourned *sine die* to do the needful. Learned counsel for the petitioners has been informed by the Registry that the matter is going to be listed for hearing on 14.03.2017 viz. today.

The case is taken up today, but there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners nor has there been any compliance of the order dated 06.10.2014. It appears that petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant writ petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
