By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No.1 & 2 to grant the benefit of military service rendered by him during emergency period i.e. July 28, 1958 to February 09, 1974 for the purpose of pension, increments, seniority in civil service with all consequential benefits.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feel satisfied in case direction is issued to the respondents, to decide his representation dated March 23, 2017 (P-8), within some specified period.

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3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated March 23, 2017 (P-8) and take a conscious decision, as per Rules and Regulations applicable to the petitioner as well as in the light of the judgment of the Hon'ble Apex Court in case *State of Haryana and another vs. Shri Om Parkash, 2006 (3) SCT 500*, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case, petitioner still feels aggrieved of the order passed by concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
