Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the instructions dated 18.06.2014 and 28.07.2014, by which regularization of certain categories of employees was ordered, are under consideration of a Division Bench and the operation of the said order/instructions have been stayed, this petition may be disposed with a direction to the respondents to not replace the petitioners herein with other ad hoc/contractual employees.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Dr. Naresh Kumar Vashist, Assistant Professor (Commerce), Government College, Mahendergarh, submits that there is no proposal to terminate the services of the petitioners.

Keeping in view the aforesaid statement as also the prayer of learned counsel for the the petitioners at this stage, which is found to be reasonable, this petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioners' services shall not be terminated by replacing them with another set of ad hoc/contractual/daily wager

employees.

Their right to regularization under the aforesaid instructions, if the validity of the aforesaid instructions is upheld by this Court, shall also remain alive.

However, it is made clear that their continuation service would obviously be dependent on their work and conduct remaining satisfactory.
