Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to given him benefit of revised pension, gratuity as per ACP (III) and Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity after counting work charge service from 12.12.1979 to 30.07.1990 with interest @ 18% per annum from the date of his retirement till payment.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feel satisfied in case direction is issued to the respondents, to decide his representation dated July 18, 2017 (P-8), within a stipulated period.

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3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated July 18, 2017 (P-8) and take a conscious decision, particularly in the light of the judgment of the Hon'ble Apex Court in case *Dakshin Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Vs. Bachan Singh*, 2009 (14) SCC 793, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case, petitioner still feels aggrieved of the order passed by concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
