The petitioners are residents of village Maholi, Tehsil Hodal, District Palwal. Their allegations are that the Gram Panchayat of their village is changing the nature of *shamlat deh* land which is reserved as 'Charand' since the time of consolidation. It is further alleged that the land reserved for 'Charand' is sought to be utilized for other purposes without prior permission or getting approved the utilization plan in terms of the decision of this Court dated 07.07.2011 in Baljinder Singh and others versus The State of Haryana and others (CWP No.13652 of 2009) (P-2), pursuant to which the State Government has already issued Instructions for preparation of land utilization plan vide memo dated 15.09.2011 (P-3). It is also alleged that on complaints made by the petitioners including Annexure P-5 (Colly.), the matter was enquired into by the B.D.P.O., Hassanpur who has submitted the report dated 03.06.2015 (P-6) to the Deputy Commissioner, Palwal fortifying the petitioners' allegations but no action is taken on the said report by the Deputy Commissioner, Palwal though more than two years have passed.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and considering the nature of relief sought in this writ petition and after going through the documents on record, we deem it appropriate to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner, Palwal, to take necessary action in accordance with law pursuant to the report dated 03.06.2015 submitted by the B.D.P.O., Hassanpur and also keeping in view the decision of this Court in Baljinder Singh and others' case (supra) read with the Government Instructions dated 15.09.2011 and 20.05.2013 (P-3 & P-4, respectively).

Ordered accordingly.

Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
