Both the parties are ad idem in view of the decision dated 8.3.2017 rendered by this Court in **Civil Writ Petition No.28576 of 2013 (Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana Versus The State of Punjab & others)**, whereby the writ petition, while upholding the order of the Financial Commissioner qua allotment of land, was dismissed.

Mr.Malkeet Singh, learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that his client would be satisfied in case the entire amount of consideration deposited in lieu of the allotment of the plot is returned by the Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana. This fact is not disputed by Mr. Samarth Sagar, learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 and 3. There is also no dispute with regard to the deposit of the total amount.

Resultantly, in view of the aforementioned fact, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-Municipal Corporation Ludhiana to return the amount of the petitioner along with interest @ 10% per annum as the same is lying deposited with the Corporation since 2004.

Let this exercise be taken within a period of one month from the receipt of the certified copy of this order.

Writ petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
