By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the release of arrears of salary which is difference of pay drawn and actually entitled to the petitioner from January 01, 1993 to April 30, 2007 the period on which the petitioner has actually worked on the post of SDE in view of the order dated March 24, 2017 passed in RA-CW-146 of 2014 in CWP No. 15794 of 2013, titled as Ram Kishan Mittal and others vs. State of Haryana.

2. At the very outset, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice dated July 07, 2017 (P-9), within a stipulated period, in view of the judgment passed by this Court in CWP No.

15794 of 2013, titled as **Ram Kishan Mittal and others vs. State of Haryana & others;** as well as order dated March 24, 2017 passed in RA-CW-146 of 2014 in CWP No. 15794 of 2013

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice (P-9) and to decide the same in view of afore-said judgment (P-6) rendered by this Court as well as order dated March 24, 2017 passed in RA-CW-146 of 2014 (P-7), that too, by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved of the order passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
