By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to refix the pension and other retirement benefits in revised pay scale w.e.f. January 01, 2006 in terms of Circular dated August 17, 2009 and February 22, 2010 (P-4 and P-5) as well as in view of judgment dated September 30, 2016 (P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No. 2866 of 2014 and LPA No. 352 of 2014 (P-2), to him along-with interest.

2. At the very outset, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice dated August 10, 2017 (P-3), within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice (P-3) and to decide the same in accordance with law as well as keeping in view of the circulars dated August 17, 2009 and February 22, 2010 (P-4 and P-5) and also in view of judgment dated September 30, 2016 (P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No. 2866 of 2014 and LPA No. 352 of 2014 (P-2), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved of the order passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
