On the asking of the Court, Mr. Vivek Singla, Advocate accepts
notice on behalf of respondent No.6.

By this writ petition, the petitioners have challenged the action
of respondents No.3 and 5 in retaining the original certificates of petitioner
No.2 on the ground that she was to pay to them fees for the entire course.

Mr. SS Brar, Advocate for respondents No.3 and 5 has fairly
stated that the certificates and sundry other belongings of petitioner No.2

which were left in the College would be returned to her. He, however, states that respondents No.3 and 5 have the right to claim the fees for the course which she had abandoned after the last date for admission was over because after her abandonment that seat has remained vacant.

Counsel for the petitioners is not in a position to deny this and rather states that respondents No.3 and 5 have already taken post-dated cheques and that is one of the reasons that the petitioners were doubly aggrieved of their inaction in not returning these cheques and thereafter retaining the certificates.

In view of this stand of counsel for the petitioners and counsel for respondents No.3 and 5, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.3 and 5 to forthwith return the original certificates and other belongings of petitioner No.2 which, as per them, were left by her. This would, however, not be taken to bar respondents No.3 and 5 to raise any claim about any unpaid fees which they are entitled to take from petitioner No.2.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
