The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India by the legal representatives of Smt. Maya Singh against whom notice dated 12.01.2017 (**Annexure P-1**) has been issued by respondent No.1 under Rule 8(1) of the Security Interest (Enforcement) Rules, 2002 in respect of House No.2758-A, Housing Board Colony, Sector 3, Faridabad.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that in view of Section 17 of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002, he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to approach the Debts Recovery Tribunal to challenge Annexure P-1.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
