On August 17, 2017, this Court had directed the Consolidation Officer, Sangrur, to decide the Claim Petition which had been filed by the private respondents within a period of two months.

[2] We are informed that in compliance thereto the Consolidation Officer has decided the Claim Petition.

[3] It was further noticed that the eviction petition filed by the Gram Panchayat against the private respondents had been adjourned *sine die* by the Collector due to pendency of the Claim Petition before the Consolidation Officer. Since the said Claim Petition has been now decided, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-

DDPO, Mansa, to decide the eviction petition filed by the Gram Panchayat against the private respondents in accordance with law and in conformity with the principles of natural justice.

[4] Let the said petition be decided expeditiously but preferably within a period six months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
