The petitioner approached this court with a direction to the respondents not to harass him being a street vendor and further directing the authorities to conduct survey in terms of the provisions of Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014.

Learned counsel for respondents No. 2 and 3, on telephonic instructions from Kulvinder Singh, Dealing Official, Municipal Corporation, Bathinda submitted that survey has already been conducted and the name of the petitioner finds mention in that.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in view of the fair stand taken by learned counsel for respondents No. 2 and 3, the present petition may be disposed of.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioner shall not be uprooted, unless he parks his vehicle/rehri for carrying on business at a place, which is a parking area or hinders traffic or pedestrian movement till such time scheme of rehabilitation is implemented.
