This petition is filed to challenge the order dated 4.10.2016 passed by the Financial Commissioner, Punjab by which he has admitted the revision petition and granted stay.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the said ROR No.754 of 2016 the petitioner had filed an application for dismissing the revision petition as it was admitted without giving notice to the petitioner and there was a huge delay. Since that application was not decided, therefore, the petitioner had approached this Court by way of CWP No.12765 of 2017 which was disposed of on 2.6.2017 directing the Financial Commissioner, who was seized of the proceedings, to decide the application for dismissal of the aforementioned ROR expeditiously. It is submitted that the said direction has not been complied with by the said Court, therefore, the petitioner had also filed contempt petition but the present petition has been filed only to challenge the order dated 4.10.2016. It is not denied by counsel for the petitioner that the application filed by him for setting aside/recalling of the order dated 4.10.2016 is still pending, therefore, the present petition is not maintainable.

Dismissed.
