Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the interest on all delayed payments of pension, pension arrears, leave encashment, DCRG and other benefits to the petitioner.
